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**AN ACT Relating to Insurance for Commercial Driver Education School  
Graduates.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 29, § 725, repealed and replaced.** Section 725 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**§ 725. Powers of Secretary of State**

The Secretary of State shall prescribe reasonable requirements, standards and qualifications for obtaining a commercial driver education school license and conduct of instructors, which requirements, standards and qualifications shall be identical to those prescribed and approved by the Commissioner of Education pursuant to Title 20, section 2452, subsection 2. The fees charged for such commercial driver education shall be subject to the approval of the Secretary of State.

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 29, § 731, additional.** Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 731, to read as follows:

**§ 731. Insurance for graduates**

Rating bureaus or independent insurers as recognized by the Insurance Commissioner shall have the authority to grant an automobile insurance discount for commercial driver education school graduates on the same basis as is granted for public school driver education graduates, provided said graduate is certified by a commercial driver education school, said commercial school to be approved in accordance with this chapter.
