AN ACT Relating to Sale or Gift of Rabbits or Fowl.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1059, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1059 to read as follows:

§ 1059. Sale or gift of rabbits or fowl

It shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale or give away within this State any live rabbits or live fowl of any kind in any quantity less than 6, unless the seller or donor receives a written statement from the purchaser or the donee stating facts which reveal that the purchaser or donee possesses adequate facilities with which to care for rabbits or fowl. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.
