**AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Black Bear.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2355-A, repealed and replaced.** Section 2355-A of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 274 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**§ 2355-A. Closed time on black bear**

There shall be a closed season on black bear from December 1st to May 15 annually. It shall be unlawful to kill or have in possession more than one such bear during any one open season, or to kill any cub of the year. Any person killing a bear shall not keep the same in any place of storage for more than 48 hours without reporting such kill to a game warden, and shall thereupon fill out the form provided therefor by the commissioner.
