HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1120, L.D. 1592, Bill, "An Act
Granting Complimentary Fishing Licenses for Certain
Maine Residents in Armed Forces."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2.-A. Complimentary licenses for Maine residents in Armed Forces. The commissioner is authorized and directed to issue complimentary fishing licenses for a period of 2 weeks or less to Maine residents in the Armed Forces of the United States who are in Maine on leave or furlough.'
