SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 612, L. D. 1597, Bill,
"An Act to Regulate the Alteration of Wetlands."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§4701" by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L. D. 1597) the underlined words and punctuation "beach, flat"; and by striking out in the 3rd line (same in L. D. 1597) the underlined words "or coastal"; and by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "waters," in the 4th line (3rd line in L. D. 1597) the underlined words and punctuation 'or remove, fill, dredge or drain sanitary sewage into, or otherwise alter any swamp, marsh, bog, beach, flat or other wetland bordering coastal waters,'
