IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Authorizing Joint Rates Between Certain Transportation Carriers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1554, amended. Section 1554 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first sentence 2 new sentences to read as follows:

When shown to be required by the public interest and consistent with the policy statement set forth in section 1551 every holder of a certificate of public convenience and necessity may establish reasonable through routes and joint rates, charges and classification with common carriers by railroad, express and water. In case of such joint rates and charges it shall be the duty of the carriers, parties thereto, to establish just and reasonable regulations and practices in connection therewith, and just, reasonable and equitable divisions thereof as between the carriers participating therein which shall not unduly prefer or prejudice any of such participating carriers.
