SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 622, L.D. 1624, Resolve,  
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Pledging Credit of  
State for Maine School Building Authority Bonds.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 3rd  
paragraph from the end and inserting in place thereof the  
following (Same in L.D. 1624):

' "Shall the Constitution which now, with certain  
exceptions, provides that the credit of the State of Maine  
shall not be directly or indirectly loaned in any case, be  
amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature pledging  
credit of the State and providing for the issuance of bonds  
not exceeding, at any one time issued and outstanding,  
twenty-five million dollars to insure the payment of revenue  
bonds of the Maine School Building Authority?" '

Proposed by Senator KATZ of Kennebec.
