HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to S.P. 635, L.D. 1635, Bill, "An Act Relating
to the Water and Air Environmental **Improvement** Commission."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 10 the following:

'Sec. 10-A. R.S., T. 38, §411, amended. The first
paragraph of section 411 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes,
as repealed and replaced by chapter 268 of the public laws of
1967, is amended by adding at the end the following:
The commission may pay up to an amount equal to 35% of the cost
of such project where they find that such project is part of
a sewerage treatment system designated to serve 2 or more
municipalities, provided such project is not eligible for
assistance 8 (f) of P.L. 660, 84th Congress, as amended.'
