SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 635, L.D. 1635,
Bill, "An Act Relating to the Water and Air Environmental
Improvement Commission."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th
paragraphs and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the
5th and 6th lines of the 6th paragraph of that part designated
"§363" (5th line in L.D. 1635) the underlined words and figures
"during at least 16 hours of any 24-hour period" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined punctuation and words ',subject, however,
to normal natural variations,'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out in the 4th
and 5th lines of the 9th paragraph of that part designated "§363"
(4th line in L.D. 1635) the underlined words and figures "during
at least 16 hours at any 24-hour period" and inserting in place
thereof the underlined punctuation and words ',subject, however,
to normal natural variations,'
