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**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Operation of the Governor's Advisory  
Committee on Education.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. Governor's Advisory Committee on Education.** The Governor shall appoint a Governor's Advisory Committee on Education to consist of no more than 34 members and a chairman. The members shall be chosen coincident with the senatorial districts established for the Maine State Senate for a 2-year term, but of those first chosen  $\frac{1}{2}$  shall be appointed for a term of one year and  $\frac{1}{2}$  for a term of 2 years. Members shall continue to serve until their successors shall have been appointed. The chairman shall be a resident of Maine and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

The committee shall continue to study the problems and future educational needs of the State as they may be requested to do so by the Governor or the Legislature and shall make periodic reports of their findings and proposals to the Governor, the various state agencies concerned with education and the Legislature when practical. The executive secretary shall be appointed by the chairman.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,350 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$4,350 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education. The breakdown shall be as follows:

**Sec. 3. Resolves, 1957, c. 160, repealed.** Chapter 160 of the resolves of 1957 is repealed.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

An Advisory Committee on Education was created by resolves, 1957, chapter 160, and the private and special laws of 1959, chapter 161. The 100th Legislature, through resolves, chapter 112, appropriated funds to provide funds for a part-time executive secretary, office space and traveling expense. This Act is for the purpose of continuing the services of a secretary and printing and mailing.
