**AN ACT Relating to Powers of Administrative Hearing Commissioner
Concerning Minors Under the Liquor Laws.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 401, sub-§ 1, amended. The 6th sentence of subsection 1 of section 401 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Administrative Hearing Commissioner is authorized to subpoena and examine witnesses ~~and~~, to administer oaths, ~~to punish for contempt and to subpoena and compel the attendance of parents and legal guardians of unemancipated minors.~~
