AN ACT Regulating Firearms in Active Lumbering Operations in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2458-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2458-A, to read as follows:

§ 2458-A. Firearms in active lumbering operations

During the closed season on deer the possession of any firearm within the limits of a lumber or pulp cutting operation, located in an unorganized township, by any person actively employed in said operation, shall be prima facie evidence of hunting deer in closed season.
