SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to H. P. 1182, L. D. 1684, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Publication of Legal Notices."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 1, §601, amended. Section 601 of Title 1  
of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the first  
sentence the following new sentence:  
In the event in a county no newspaper entered as second class postal  
matter and satisfying the requirements of this section is published  
and printed or has its principal place of business in such county,  
any legal notices, legal advertising or other matter required by  
law to be published in a newspaper in said county may be published  
in a newspaper satisfying such requirements except that it is  
published and printed or has its principal place of business in  
an adjoining county.'
