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**AN ACT Relating to Salary and Expenses of Third Member of Atlantic Sea Run  
Salmon Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 3601, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, sub-¶ (4), amended.** Subparagraph (4) of paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 3601 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

(4) ~~The 3rd member is entitled to receive \$10 per day and expenses when engaged in the discharge of his official duties~~ shall receive an annual salary of \$1,500. He shall receive necessary expenses when engaged in the discharge of his official duties.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission the sum of \$1,125 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969. The breakdown shall be as follows:
