SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1196, L. D. 1699, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Highway Commission Land Taking."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§160. Loss of profits

An award for taking by eminent domain shall include as an
additional element of damages a loss of profits prior to the
actual taking, where it is shown that such loss of profits resulted
from any preliminary act or communication incidental to the
taking.'
