# STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to Membership of the Advisory Council of the Department of Economic Development.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 404, amended. The first sentence of section 404 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

A Department of Economic Development Advisory Council, as heretofore established, shall consist of 7 9 members appointed by the Covernor for a term of 3 years, provided that of the members first appointed, one shall be appointed for a term of one year, 3 for a term of 2 years and 3 for a term of 3 years: one legislator from the majority party and one legislator from the minority party in the Senate and one legislator from the majority party and one legislator from the minority party in the House of Representatives and 5 persons representing all phases of economic activity of this State, to be appointed by the Governor, to serve a term of 3 years and until his successor is appointed and qualified.
