HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1206, L.D. 1717, Resolve, Proposing

Amendments to the Constitution Relating to Bond Issues to be

Voted Upon by the People.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by striking out the words
"Bond Issues to be Voted Upon by the People" and inserting in
place thereof the words 'Temporary Loans in Anticipation of State
Tax Revenues and Limitations Thereon'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph from the end and inserting in place thereof the following:

' "Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature Relating to Temporary Loans in Anticipation of State Tax Revenues and Limitations Thereon?" '
