HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 695, L. D. 1731, Bill, "An Act Increasing Compensation of Court Justices and Certain Department Heads."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 24. R. S., T. 3, §2, amended. The first sentence of section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

Each member of the Senate and House of Representatives shall receive \$2,000 \$3,000 for the regular session of the Legislature, and shall be paid for travel at each legislative session once each week at the same rate per mile to and from his place of abode as state employees receive, the mileage to be determined by the most reasonable direct route.

- Sec. 25. R. S., T. 3 §2, amended. The first sentence of the 3rd paragraph of section 2 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:
- The President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Representatives shall each receive \$2,300 \$3,300 for each regular session of the Legislature, with the same mileage as other members, and subject to the same deduction in case of each absence.
 - Sec. 26. Effective date. Sections 24 and 25 of this Act shall become effective on the first Wednesday of January, 1969.
