HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1218, L.D. 1734, Bill, "An Act to
Create the Department of Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by adding at the end, a new
paragraph, as follows:

'Whenever the Governor and Council, upon due notice and
hearing, shall find that the director is not faithfully or
efficiently performing any duty imposed upon him by law, the
Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, may remove
the director from office.'
