SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1218, L. D. 1734, Bill, "An Act to Create the Department of Alcoholic Beverages."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§51." by striking out all of the 2nd underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

'The head of the department shall be the Director of Alcoholic Beverages, hereinafter in this Title called the "director," who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor. The compensation of the director shall be \$20,000 per year.'
