STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Mandatory Competitive Bids on State Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 5, § 1714, sub-§ 3, amended. The first paragraph of subsection 3 of section 1714 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Place such insurance with companies or agents licensed to do business in the State of Maine to effect the best possible contracts as to services, coverages and costs; such placement customarily shall be made by competitive bidding, except that the board may in exceptional circumstances, if the board shall certify that the subject matter is not an appropriate one for competitive bidding, place insurance by negotiation.
