AN ACT Relating to Mandatory Competitive Bids on State Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 5, § 1714, sub-§ 3, amended. The first paragraph of subsection 3 of section 1714 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Place such insurance with companies or agents licensed to do business in the State of Maine to effect the best possible contracts as to services, coverages and costs ; such placement ~~customarily~~ shall be made by competitive bidding, except that the board may ~~in exceptional circumstances~~, **if the board shall certify that the subject matter is not an appropriate one for competitive bidding**, place insurance by negotiation.
