HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1259, L.D. 1765, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 (same in L.D. 1765) a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 2-A. R.S., T. 20, §302, amended. The next to the last paragraph of section 302 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 6-C of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

No member of the board of school directors er-speuse shall be employed as a teacher or in any other capacity in any public school that comes within the jurisdiction of the board of directors of which he is a member.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after section 3 (same in L.D. 1765) a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. R.S., T. 20, §472, amended. The 4th sentence of section 472 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 6-D and 19 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

No member of the school committee of any such town er-speuse shall be employed as a teacher in any public school or contract high school or academy located within a supervisory union of which he is a member of the joint committee.'
