SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1259, L.D. 1765, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 22. General purpose school aid for the city of Lewiston. The computation of general purpose school aid allotted to the City of Lewiston and payable in the calendar years 1968, 1969 and 1970, notwithstanding any other provision of the Revised Statutes, Title 20, shall be accomplished in the following manner:

1. Subsidy computation. All pupils resident of Lewiston who attended St. Mary's School shall be counted in the subsidy computation as though they had been attending public schools during the applicable subsidy years.

2. Allowable expenditures. For the purposes of computation of general purpose subsidies allotted to the City of Lewiston for the calendar years specified above, the allowable elementary per pupil expenditure amounts shall be the lesser of the elementary per pupil expenditures of the City of Lewiston, or the state average elementary per pupil expenditures for the applicable subsidy periods.'
