STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Bank Commissioner.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the Bank Commissioner's position has been vacant since August, 1967; and

Whereas, the vacancy at this point in time leaves a dangerous void in our economy; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the State Legislature to have a fully qualified Bank Commissioner; and

Whereas, no person properly qualified has been found to fill this position who will serve at the salary presently established for the Bank Commissioner; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 9, § 1, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section I of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

He (Bank Commissioner) shall receive an annual salary of \$16,588 \$22,000 and his actual traveling expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
