## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT

## AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Subordinate Officers of Senate and House of Representatives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 3, § 21, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 21 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

After the election of the President, the Senate shall proceed to elect by ballot a secretary and an assistant secretary a sergeant at arms, an assistant secretary and a pages.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 3, § 41, amended. The 3rd sentence of the first paragraph of section 41 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

After the election of the Speaker, the House of Representatives shall proceed to elect by ballot a clerk and an assistant clerk a sergeant at arms, an assistant sergeant at arms, a document clerk, a doorkeeper and a pages.
