HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 753, L.D. 1811, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Compensation for Certain Municipal Officers  
who Appear in District Court."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end a new section, as  
follows:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 4, §173, sub-§4, amended. The  
second sentence of the 4th paragraph of subsection 4 of section  
173 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter  
244 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as  
follows:

The Treasurer of State shall pay the municipality \$4 each time  
one of the latter's law enforcement officers duly signs, as  
arresting officer, the return of a criminal warrant or complaint,  
issued by the District Court.'
