**AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Certain Municipal Officers who
Appear in District Court.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 4, § 173, sub-§ 4, amended. The next to the last paragraph of subsection 4 of section 173 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 397 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

All municipal police officers, sheriffs, deputy sheriffs or constables who officially appear for a scheduled trial in and for the District Court at times other than their regular working hours shall be compensated out of the ~~District Court Fund on an hourly basis equal to their present rate of employment as determined and ordered for payment by the District Court Judge~~ General Fund and receive the same fee as any other witnesses.
