SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 759, L. D. 1816, Bill, "An Act Establishing Procedures for State Medical Examiners and Creating the Office of Chief Medical Examiner for the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence of that part designated "§3022" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'The Chief Medical Examiner of the State of Maine shall be appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, for a term of 7 years and until his successor is appointed and qualified.'
