IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-EIGHT

AN ACT Relating to Payment for Blood Tests in the District Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1312, amended. The 7th sentence of section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 408 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

All such tests made to determine the weight of alcohol in the blood shall be paid for ~~from the District Court Fund~~ by the county wherein the violation of this section was alleged to have occurred.
