AN ACT to Change Date of Caucus Election of City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 71, § 2, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 71 of the private and special laws of 1933, as last amended by chapter 134 of the private and special laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Only those voters enrolled as qualified to vote in such caucuses as hereinafter provided shall participate therein; all nominations by petition or as provided by the Maine Revised Statutes shall be voted upon at the next municipal election, and the caucus for such candidates by petition or by said nomination papers shall be held in the several wards of the city on the last Monday of November, ~~biennially~~ **annually**, on which day the polls will be opened at 9 o'clock in the forenoon and continue open to 8 o'clock in the evening, when they shall close.
