SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1299, L.D. 1828, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funds for Blind Children's Education, Inc."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on June 30, 1969, provided only if there is in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund a sum in excess of \$200,000 on that date.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the emergency clause.
