**AN ACT Proposing a Salary Plan for Certain Unclassified State Officials.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 2, § 6, additional.** Title 2 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 6, to read as follows:

**§ 6. Salaries**

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, is authorized to adjust:

1. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$21,000:

Chairman of the Highway Commission;  
Commissioner of Economic Development;  
Commissioner of Education;  
Commissioner of Finance and Administration;  
Commissioner of Health and Welfare;  
Commissioner of Mental Health and Corrections.

2. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$17,500:

Attorney General;  
Chairman of the Employment Security Commission;

Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission;  
 Bank Commissioner;  
 Forest Commissioner;  
 Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game;  
 Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries;  
 Director of Legislative Research;  
 Director of Personnel;  
 Director of Public Improvements;  
 State Budget Officer;  
 State Controller;  
 State Police Chief;

3. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$15,000:

Adjutant General;  
 Assistant Director of Legislative Research;  
 Business Administrator of the Liquor Commission;  
 Chairman of the Industrial Accident Commission;  
 Commissioner of Agriculture;  
 Insurance Commissioner;  
 Deputy Attorney General;  
 Aeronautical Director;  
 Director of Transportation of Public Utilities Commission;  
 Director of State Parks and Recreation;  
 Employment Security Commission Members, other than the chairman;  
 Executive Secretary of Sardine Tax Committee;  
 Legislative Finance Officer;  
 Manager of Industrial Building Authority;  
 Public Utilities Commission Members, other than the chairman;  
 Purchasing Agent;  
 Secretary of the Retirement Board;  
 Secretary of State;  
 State Auditor;  
 Treasurer of State.

4. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$12,000:

Assistant Legislative Finance Officer;  
 Chairman of the Liquor Commission;  
 Civil Defense Director;  
 Commissioner of Indian Affairs;

Commissioner of Labor and Industry;  
Commissioner of Veterans Services;  
Examiner and Chief Accountant of Public Utilities Commission;  
General Counsel of the Public Utilities Commission;  
Industrial Accident Commission Members, other than the chairman;  
State Librarian;  
Deputy Chief of the State Police.

5. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$10,000:

Deputy Adjutant General;  
Executive Director of the Board of Registry of Nurses;  
Executive Secretary of the Committee on Problems of the Mentally Retarded;  
Executive Secretary of the Highway Safety Committee;  
Manager of Maine State Ferry Service.

The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$9,000:

Chief Inspector of Boilers and Deputy Inspector of Elevators;  
Supervising Elevator Inspector and Deputy Boiler Inspector.

7. The salaries of Assistant Attorneys General II to no more than a range of \$9,500 to \$13,000.

8. The salaries of Assistant Attorneys General I to no more than a range of \$7,500 to \$10,000.

9. The salaries of the State Highway Commissioners, other than the chairman, to no more than \$6,000.
