HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 772, L.D. 1844, Bill, "An Act Establishing a State Planning Office."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 3302." by striking out all of paragraph A of subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Preparation of long-range plans and goals for human and physical resources development and utilization;'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 3304." by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'2. Qualifications. The director shall be qualified by education, training and experience in planning or public administration with a master's degree in these or related fields.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 3304." by striking out in the last line of subparagraph (1), paragraph A of subsection 3, the underlined words "and transportation" and inserting in place thereof the underlined punctuation and words ',transportation and engineering';

Further amend said Bill in section 1 of that part designated "§ 3304." by striking out in the 2nd line of paragraph D of subsection 3, the underlined words "and advise" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'and advice'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 3306." by striking out all of subsection 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'3. Duties. The State Planning Council shall meet at least twice each year and at other times at the request of the Governor.'

In addition, the chairman shall call a meeting of the council whenever requested to do so by the State Planning Director or by any 4 members, or he may do so on his own initiative.'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out the first 8 lines (same in L.D. 1844) under the heading "EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'State Planning Office

Personal Services

(5) \$53,550'
