SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 756, L.D. 1867, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following new section:

'Sec. 118. R.S., T. 23, §1101, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1101 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 438 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

Towns having a valuation of \$500,000 or less may appropriate any amount not exceeding \$300; towns having a valuation of over \$500,000 and not over \$1,600,000 may appropriate any amount not exceeding \$533; towns having a valuation of over \$1,600,000 and not over \$2,000,000 may appropriate an amount not exceeding \$600; and towns having a valuation of over \$2,000,000 and not over \$6,000,000 may appropriate in addition to the sum of \$600 an additional sum of \$66 for each ~~\$500,000~~ \$400,000 or fraction thereof valuation in excess of \$2,000,000; towns having a valuation of over \$6,000,000 and not over \$8,000,000 may appropriate not exceeding \$1,333; and towns having a valuation of over \$8,000,000 may appropriate in addition to the sum of \$1,333 an additional sum not exceeding \$133 for each additional \$2,000,000 or fraction thereof of additional valuation.'
