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**AN ACT Relating to Hearings Before Water and Air Environmental Improvement Commission.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 38, § 451, sub-§ 2, amended.** The first paragraph of subsection 2 of section 451 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 11 of chapter 475 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**Whenever it appears to the commission after investigation that a violation of this subchapter is being committed, the commission shall schedule a hearing thereon and shall notify the alleged violator in writing of the time and place of such hearing and shall set forth in said writing the act done or omitted to be done which is claimed to be in violation of this subchapter. At such hearing the alleged violator may appear in person or by attorney and answer the allegations of violation and file a statement of the facts, including the methods, practices and procedures, if any, adopted or used by the alleged violator to comply with this subchapter and present such evidence as may be pertinent and relevant to the alleged violation.**
