SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1333, L. D. 1878, Bill, "An Act Relating to Referendum Under Maine Housing Authorities Act."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 1, the following underlined paragraph:

'Further provided that nothing contained in this section shall require the holding of any referendum to authorize the housing authority of any city or town whose population is in excess of 60,000 to enter into any contract for loans, grants, contributions or other financial assistance with the Federal Government for any project, if the project is within a defined area of the city or town previously designated by the authority and approved by the voters by referendum for the location of public housing projects.'
