SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1335, L.D. 1879, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Tax on Real Estate Transfers."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated
"§4652" by adding after the underlined word "sold" in the last line
(same in L.D. 1879) the underlined words and punctuation 'and when
such stamps are sold by the registers of deeds the said 10% shall
be for the use of the counties, and the said sums shall be turned
over by the registers of deeds to the county treasurers monthly'
