SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 3, L. D. 3, RESOLVE, in Favor of the City of Augusta.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by adding at the end, before the period, the words 'and the Town of Greenbush'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'City of Augusta and Town of Greenbush, reimbursed. Resolved:
That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$28,000 to be paid to the City of Augusta as reimbursement for loss of tax revenue on the Internal Revenue Building for the years 1964, 1965 and 1966; and the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to the Town of Greenbush as reimbursement for loss of tax revenue on state-owned land and buildings for the year 1968.'
