**AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Directors of the Maine Port Authority.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1929, c. 114, § 2, sub-§ (a), amended.** The 3rd sentence of subsection (a) of section 2 of chapter 114 of the private and special laws of 1929 is amended to read as follows:

Each director shall receive from the Port Authority an annual salary of ~~five hundred dollars~~ \$1,200, and shall be reimbursed for all expenses incurred in the discharge of his duties as such director.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$6,125 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
