STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Muskrat and Mink.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection 1 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 27 of chapter 544 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following paragraphs enacted in place thereof:

The open season on mink shall be during the month of November in each calendar year.

The open season on muskrat shall be during the months of November, December, January, February and March of each calendar year.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, 2358, sub-§ 2, repealed. Subsection 2 of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.
