HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 21, L. D. 24, Resolve, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Convening of the Legislature at Such Times as the Legislature Deems Necessary.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 9th, 10th and 11th lines (7th, 8th and 9th lines of L. D. 24) the underlined words and punctuation "and, as provided by rule, at such other times as they deem necessary on the call of the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House" and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words and punctuation 'and at such other times, on the call of the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House, as the Legislature may prescribe by joint rules'
