HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 29, L. D. 30, Bill, "AN  
ACT Amending the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 (same in  
L.D. 30) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, §1, sub-§7, amended. Subsection 7  
of section 1 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to  
read as follows:

7. Clerk. "Clerk" means the clerk or deputy clerk of a  
municipality.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, §43, sub-§4, amended. Subsection 4  
of section 43 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by  
adding after the first sentence, a new sentence, as follows:  
A board of registration may only act by unanimous or majority  
action. '

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 2 to 7  
to be sections 3 to 8.
