STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Allocations to the Town Road Improvement Fund.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1703, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 1703 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Legislature shall appropriate allocate the sum of \$2,000,000 for each fiscal year such amounts as it shall deem proper from the General Highway Fund, but not to exceed 10% of the average annual gross income from the gasoline tax and registration fees for motor vehicles, the average to be that of the preceding 5-year period.
