STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Baiting of Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 12, § 2354, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2354 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 2. Salt or other bait. It shall be unlawful to place salt or any other bait or food in any place for the purpose of enticing deer or bear thereto.
