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**AN ACT** Relating to Settlement Status of Persons Residing in Rest Homes  
and Nursing Homes.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 22, § 4453, amended.** The last sentence of section 4453 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The settlement status of a person in the military or naval service of the United States or of a person who is an inmate of any asylum, penitentiary, jail, reformatory or other state institution, **or a person residing in a rest home, nursing home or boarding home** shall not change during such period of service, confinement ~~or~~, imprisonment **or residence**, but his settlement shall remain as it was at the time of the beginning of such service, confinement ~~or~~, imprisonment **or residence**.
