## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Tenure of Office of Assistant Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 3, § 164, sub-§ 12, amended. Subsection 12 of section 164 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- 12. Assistants. The director shall appoint, with the approval of the Legislative Research Committee, an assistant director for a term of 6 years from the date of his appointment, and such technical assistants, and shall appoint, subject to the Personnel Law, such clerical assistants, as may be necessary to carry out this chapter.
