STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 104th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 43, L. D. 44, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Legislative Research Committee Officials."

Amend said Bill in section 4 by inserting after the underlined word "salary" in the 6th line (same in L.D.) the underlined words and figure 'not to exceed \$16,500'

Further amend said Bill in section 5 by inserting after the underlined word "salary" in the 6th line (5th line in L.D.) the underlined words and figure 'not to exceed \$16,500'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following sections:

'Sec. 6. R. S., T. 3, §163, sub-§15, amended. The first sentence of the next to the last paragraph of subsection 15 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2-D of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1965 and repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 8 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The Finance Officer shall appoint, with the approval of the Legislative Research Committee, an assistant finance officer to assist the Finance Officer in carrying out his duties and his salary shall not exceed \$15,000, to be approved by the Legislative Research Committee.

Sec. 7. R. S., T. 3, §164, sub-§12, amended. Subsection 12 of section 164 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 8 of the public laws of 1969, is further

amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

The salary of the assistant director shall not exceed \$15,000,
to be approved by the Legislative Research Committee.

Sec. 8. Effective date. Sections 6 and 7 of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.
