AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Legislative Research Committee Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, § 6, sub-§ 4, amended. The 7th and 10th lines of subsection 4 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 542 of the public laws of 1967, which pertain to the salaries of the Director of Legislative Research and the Legislative Finance Officer, are repealed as follows:

~~Director of Legislative Research;~~

~~Legislative Finance Officer;~~

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 2, § 6, sub-§ 5, amended. The 12th line of subsection 5 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 542 of the public laws of 1967, which pertains to the salary of the Assistant Legislative Finance Officer, is repealed as follows:

~~Assistant Legislative Finance Officer;~~

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 2, § 6, sub-§ 6, amended. The 3rd line of subsection 6 of section 6 of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 542 of the public laws of 1967, which pertains to the salary of the Assistant Director of Legislative Research, is repealed as follows:

~~Assistant Director of Legislative Research;~~

Sec. 4. R. S., T. 3, § 163, sub-§ 7, amended. The last sentence of subsection 7 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965 and by section 1 of chapter 476

of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Legislative Research Committee shall fix his salary and he (Director) shall receive any necessary traveling expenses;

Sec. 5. R. S., T. 3, § 163, sub-§ 15, amended. The 4th sentence of subsection 15 of section 163 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 341 of the public laws of 1965 and by section 2 of chapter 476 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof: **The Legislative Research Committee shall fix his salary and he (Legislative Finance Officer) shall receive any necessary traveling expenses, which salary and expenses shall be paid from the legislative appropriation.**
