SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 44, L.D. 45, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Expenses of the Clerk of the House of Representatives."

Amend said Bill, in the Title, by inserting at the end before
the period the following 'and the Secretary of the Senate'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause
the following:

'Sec. 1. R.S., T. 3, §22, amended. The last sentence of the
first paragraph of section 22 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes,
as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

He shall receive a salary of \$9,000 in full for all official services
by him performed during the regular session of the Legislature and
a salary of \$1,500 a year when the Legislature is not in session
and all necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his
official duties at the same rate for room, meals and mileage as
allowed to legislators.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line, after the enacting clause, the following underlined
abbreviation and figure 'Sec.2.'
